

Summer Camp Emergency Guidelines

Fire:

- ORU Security will respond to all fire alarms
- Fire Extinguishers are on all floors of the resident halls.
- All resident halls are equipped with emergency water sprinklers and smoke alarms.
- Fire evacuation routes are posted on all floors.
- Anyone staying in the resident halls should familiarize themselves with the evacuation routes for their particular floor.
- ORU Security and Camp Staff is responsible to coordinate any evacuation.
- Elevators will not operate once an alarm has begun, all evacuation must proceed by utilizing the stairways.
- Camp Staff will conduct a head count as soon as possible to assure all campers have been evacuated.
- All evacuees shall move into the parking area away from the building in alarm.

Medical:

- ORU Security and Camp Staff make all necessary 911 EMSA notifications.
- Any serious campus medical emergencies will be addressed by EMSA.
- All emergency medical transports will be conducted by EMSA.
- ORU Security may transport for minor medical issues.
- Only parents or guardians may sign medical a release form for their minor child.

Severe Weather Evacuations:

- ORU will sound an alarm.
- ORU Security and Camp Staff will coordinate evacuations.
- Camp Staff will conduct a head count as soon as feasible.
- Do not attempt to use elevators all evacuations should be conducted using the stairways.

Safety:

- ORU Security Officers and Camp Staff will conduct a regular walk-through in the resident halls.
- Camp Staff and Campers must display identification at all times while on campus.
- No unauthorized persons are allowed in the resident halls.
- Any unauthorized individual should immediately be reported to ORU Security (7750) or Camp Staff.
- Any unauthorized person on campus who is not connected to the camp session or the University will be subject to eviction.
- The Director of Public Safety and Security will be notified of any eviction.
